## **'Somebody's Daughter: A Journey to Freedom from Pornography'**

***Public premiere of music videos from new documentary revealing the damaging effects of pornography in the Christian community set for Sept. 27***

***Concert features major contemporary Christian recording artists***

ORLANDO, Fla. –Videos from "Somebody's Daughter: A Journey to Freedom from Pornography", a new television documentary detailing the impact of pornography on the Christian community, will premiere on Sept. 27 at 7 p.m. at Trinity Baptist Church in Apopka, Fla.

The premiere will be attended by Steve Siler, award-winning songwriter and founder of Music for the Soul, and feature live musical performances by contemporary Christian recording artists Clay Crosse, Scott Krippayne and John Mandeville. In addition, all of the music from the "Somebody's Daughter" CD will be performed live.

The event is presented by Music for the Soul and Unshackled Ministries.

According to recent surveys, nearly 60 percent of Christian men and 37 percent of pastors admit to struggling with pornography. No longer just a problem for men, 35 percent of women also admit to the addiction.

"Somebody's Daughter" was produced to shine the light on how the \$13.3 billion pornography industry is plaguing members of the church, and to promote healing and deliverance from the growing epidemic," said Siler.

"Somebody's Daughter" details the lives of three men and one couple active in Christian ministry, while struggling with addictions to pornography, and is scheduled to air on the ION Television Network (formerly PAX TV) Nov. 30 and Dec. 7. The documentary also is slated to air on INSP, Faith TV and "It's Time for Herman & Sharron."
