

Somebody's Daughter

Success stories

A Denver area therapist shared with us that there was a man he was counseling who had been struggling with pornography since he was a child. He introduced the Somebody's Daughter CD into their therapy sessions as a way to help keep the patient from acting out on his addiction between sessions.

After a few months the patient's wife had to go out of town for two weeks. The man carried Somebody's Daughter with him and listened to it at home, in the car, and at even work during the time his wife was away.

He reported to the therapists upon his wife's return that he had been able to go the entire two weeks alone without acting out on his pornography addiction – the first time he had gone two weeks without using pornography in his entire adult life.



A Florida man called to tell me that he and his wife had not had sexual relations in twenty years. She'd had a medical condition that had made sex painful, so he had retreated into pornography.

They had lived together in this denial for two decades. Then a friend gave him *Somebody's Daughter*. After listening he was convicted that his choice had been a mistake that had created a horrible distance between him and his wife. He went to her and asked her to listen to the CD with him.

As they listened together she got in touch with her anger over the last twenty years. First they screamed - then they held each other and cried and cried.

The man said, "I wanted to call and thank you for giving me back my life...for giving me back my wife."



A therapist from Oregon called and told me that he began playing the song *Free* from *Somebody's Daughter* on 'repeat' in his waiting room. He told me that it is creating a different atmosphere and was giving people hope.

He shared with me that one client came into the room after hearing the song and said, "You mean my husband can actually be free?"

He also shared that he has already used the Somebody's Daughter music video with fathers who have a problem with pornography with powerful effect.

This same therapist is also using the song *Free* as “the final word” on a class he teaches on sexual addiction at a local University.
