



Dear Therapist,

When we create songs for the Music for the Soul catalog, we always pray that they will be specific enough to serve the intended audience we have in mind - and broad enough to serve the audience God has in mind. We know that only God knows where these songs will ultimately go and who will hear them.

Allow me to share two examples, one from an individual and one from a group setting.

When we released the *More Beautiful* Project for breast cancer patients and their families the very first letter we received was from a woman who'd had throat surgery. She had a scar that bothered her and was wearing turtlenecks every day to cover it up. She lived in Lancaster, California, where the temperature averages above 80 degrees six months out of the year. "When I heard *More Beautiful*, I threw my turtlenecks away," she told us. We hadn't written a song about throat surgery. Nevertheless, the message of the song spoke to her.

Another time I was playing a conference for sexual abuse survivors. It was the end of what had been a very intense first day of meetings. I decided to play *I've Got This*, a song about having trouble sleeping. When I finished the conference leader asked the gathering of 125, "How many of you have difficulty sleeping?" Over two-thirds of the hands in the room went up. In writing a song about insomnia, I had not had the specific issue of sexual abuse in mind. Yet clearly it resonated with the majority of the survivors in the audience that night.

It's our hope that this index will quickly direct you to songs that will help you serve your clients. But please don't be limited to *only* using the songs based on the categories we've put them in. We invite you to consider your clients as you listen. You know the particulars of each client's circumstances, where they are in their healing process, and what will best serve them.

One other note. You'll not see a category for trauma on this list. Since so many of the issues we address can be traumatic I trust that you will best know when song would be beneficial to help a client process their trauma.

Finally, we want this listing to be as helpful as possible. If you feel strongly that a song should be added to another category in the index, please let us know.

God bless you as you serve those in need of healing.
